Long-term training periods represent a unique opportunity to get acquainted with the work, procedures, and decision-making of the EPPO, CJEU, the ECtHR, and Eurojust. Depending on the institution they apply for, participants might be assigned to the chamber of a Member of the CJEU or to the National Desk of their Member State within Eurojust. EJTN long-term trainee can join a case processing unit at the ECtHR or be appointed to the operations unit of the EPPO. We encourage you to review the training requirements to explore the exciting opportunities available for our long-term trainees.

When

The call for applications is issued in September. Participants interested in the long-term training periods can apply until mid-October.

APPLICATIONS

All applications must be submitted between September and mid-October. Applicants must have the authorisation of their national hierarchy to be detached for a long-term training period prior to applying.

When French is the working language (CJEU), applicants must provide proof of their language knowledge.
